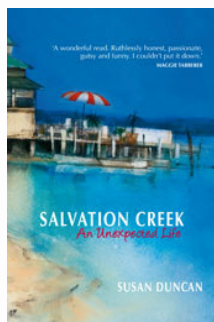


# Book Club Discussion Notes

### About the book

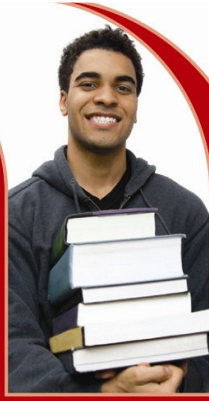

She shoulders her burden and carries on for 18 months when she finds herself unable simply to get out of bed.
