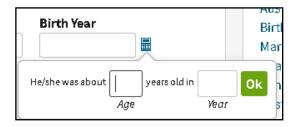
- 1. Access Ancestry Library from the Logan City Council Libraries website loganlibraries.org
- 2. Click on Discover> eResources> Genealogy and Family History> Ancestry Library
- 3. Enter your Library Card number and PIN when prompted.
- 4. Please note that Ancestry Library is only accessible in person at Logan City Council Library branch locations.

## Searching tips:

- 1. From the Home page there are options for searching. The Begin Searching button takes you to a general search page, or you can search CENSUS, VITALS, MILITARY and IMMIGRATION.
- 2. The general search allows for truncation and wildcards (?or \*) so you can search for variations in spelling:



Auto suggest will load locations as you begin typing. If you are unsure of the birth year, select the calculator.



3. Click Show more options to add an event such as Births, Deaths, Marriages
