



Looking for the latest eBooks and eAudio online?
Try **BorrowBox**, available now on the Logan City Council Libraries website.

Get started:

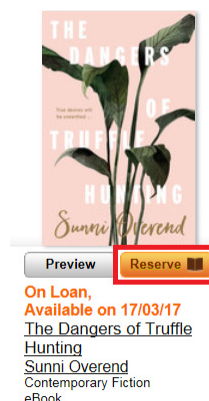
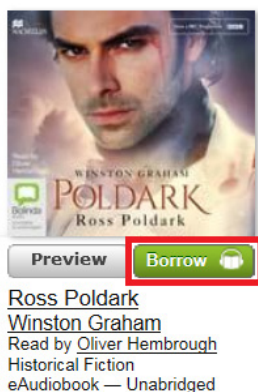
1. Access [BorrowBox](#) from the Logan City Council Libraries website [loganlibraries.org](#)
2. Click on eLibrary > eBooks > *BorrowBox*.
3. Click on the green **Sign In** button at the top right of the landing page.
4. Enter you Library card barcode and PIN number, and click Login.

Searching and browsing:

1. **Search** for a title, author, narrator or subject using the search box at the top right of the page.
 - a. Or click on Advance Search for more search options.
 - b. **Tip:** Tick the Show only available titles box after a search to show only those you can borrow now.
2. It's easy to **browse BorrowBox** and find your next great read:
 - a. Explore the front page of the site where you will find lots of handy booklists.
 - b. Click on [eAudiobooks](#) or [eBooks](#) across the top bar of the site. From here you can select to go to the Adult, Young Adult or Children's page, or browse one of the Featured lists. Hover over the yellow [Browse by Category](#) button to reveal even more lists.

Checkouts and downloads:

1. If the title has a green Borrow button, it is available. Click on Borrow, then Confirm eBook/ eAudiobook Loan to **checkout** the title. (eBooks and eAudiobooks can be loaned for up to 14 days. You can borrow and reserve up to 10 eBooks and 10 eAudiobooks at a time).
2. If the title has a yellow Reserve button, it is not currently available. Simply click on **Reserve** then Confirm Reserve to add yourself to the queue. The title will be automatically checked out to you when it becomes available.



3. All Loans and Reserves can be found under [My Account](#) located along the top bar of any page. You can download and renew titles from here.
4. To **download an eBook** to your computer:
 - a. You will need to install [Adobe Digital Editions](#) to download eBooks to your PC or Mac computer. You will also need it for OverDrive and EBSCO eBooks so it is well worth it.
 - i. Once you have downloaded **ADE** on first launch go to Help > Authorise Computer. On the following screen choose [Adobe ID](#) from the dropdown menu and enter your Adobe ID and password.
 - b. On the BorrowBox site, under [My Account](#) click on Download next to the title you wish to download, then click on Download for eReader.
 - i. Save the file when prompted. Navigate to where the file is saved (check your Downloads folder), and double click to open in **ADE**.
5. To **download an eAudiobook** to your computer:
 - a. Under [My Account](#) click Download and choose to download the eAudiobook either in a single download or in parts. Save the file when prompted.
 - b. Now unzip the eAudiobook.
 - i. **PC.** Find your downloaded eAudiobook folder. Right click on the folder and select *Extract All*, then follow the prompts to finish unzipping.
 - ii. **Mac.** Locate your eAudiobook folder, then double click to unzip.
 - c. Drag and drop the unzipped eAudiobook folder to iTunes or Windows Media Player.
 - d. You may also connect your MP3 player to your computer and drag and drop the unzipped eAudiobook folder to the device.

Using the mobile app:

1. You can use the BorrowBox mobile app to read and listen to eBooks and eAudiobooks quickly and easily. We recommend using the Borrowbox app as the best and easiest way to listen to eAudiobooks.
2. Download the BorrowBox App from either the [Apple App Store](#) or [Google Play](#) (for Android) to your portable smart device.
3. **Get set up:**
 - a. Open the app. Search for and select 'Logan's Libraries' as the library, and enter in your Library Card and PIN numbers in the space provided. Tap Sign In. Agree to the terms and conditions.
4. Borrow and read a title straight from the app:
 - a. Along the bottom bar, select eAudiobooks or eBooks, or select Search if you know exactly what you want.
 - b. Browse through the featured categories.
 - c. Choose a title, tap on it, then tap Borrow to **checkout**. If the title is on loan, tap Reserve.
 - d. Your borrowed items, and reserves, will be found under My Loans. Anything you have checked out on a computer will also be automatically synced to your device.
 - e. If you are connected to Wi-Fi titles will automatically download, tap on one and **start reading** or listening! (Note: If you are on a network connection you will have to change your settings to enable the title to download. Tap Settings, then allow Cellular Downloads.)
