- Libraries are public places and parents and carers are responsible for the due care and safety of their children.

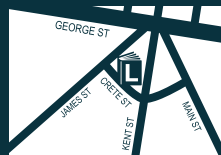

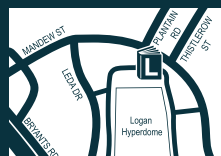

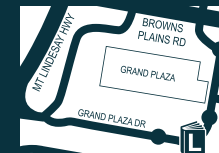
