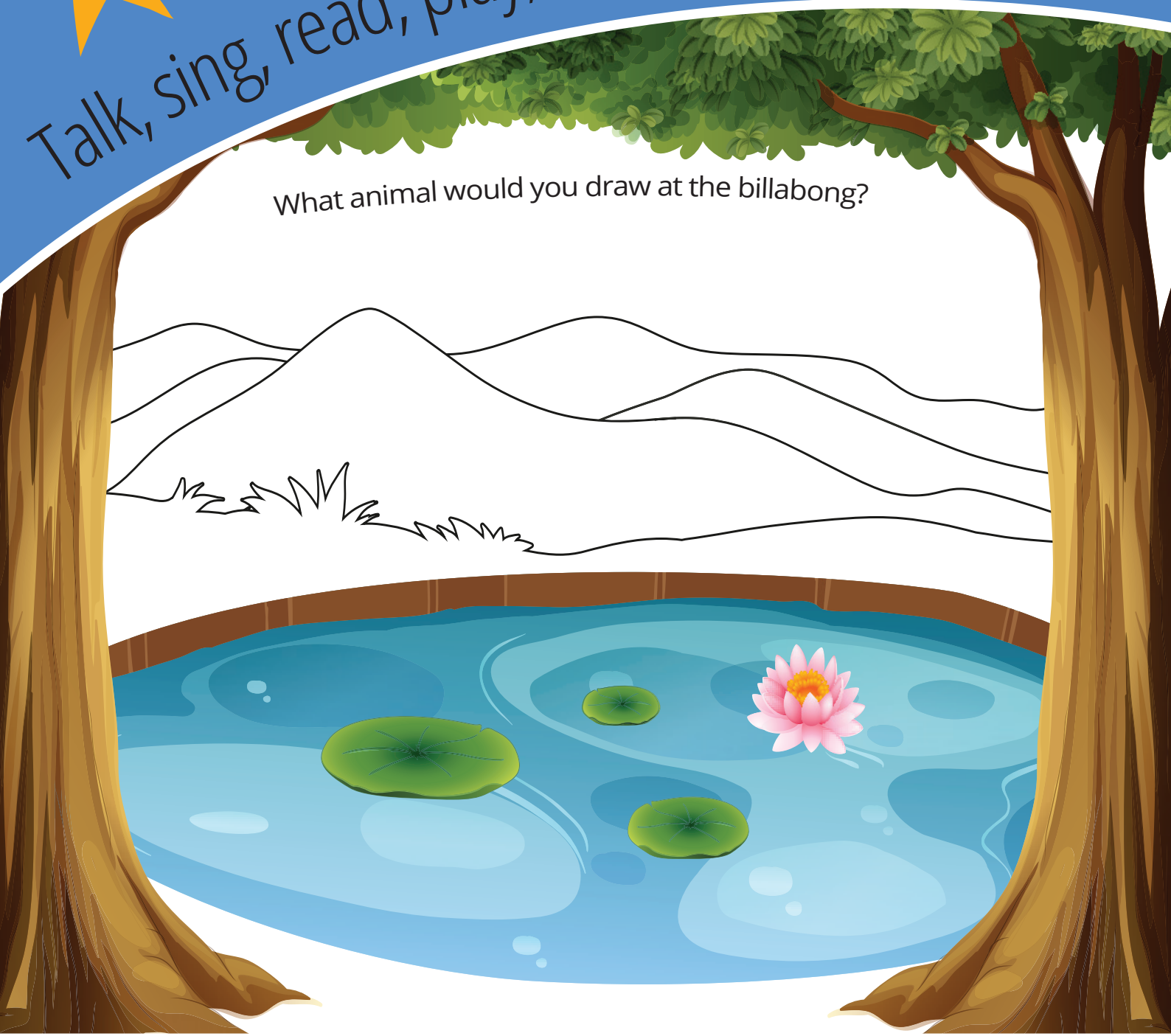

The most important person in a child's life is YOU!

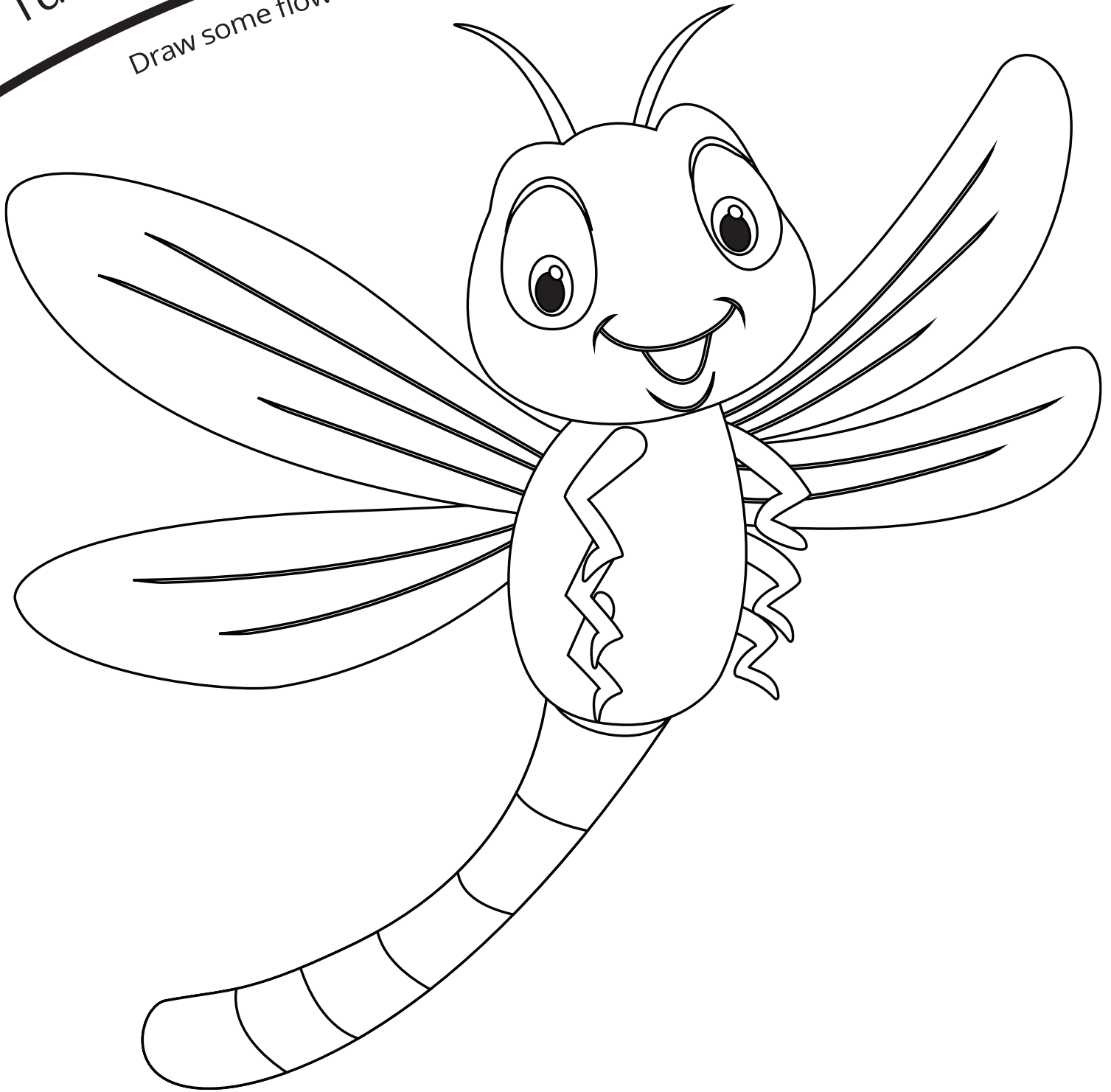


The most important time for a child's brain development is in their first five years of life.

Draw some flowers together for the dragonfly to land on.



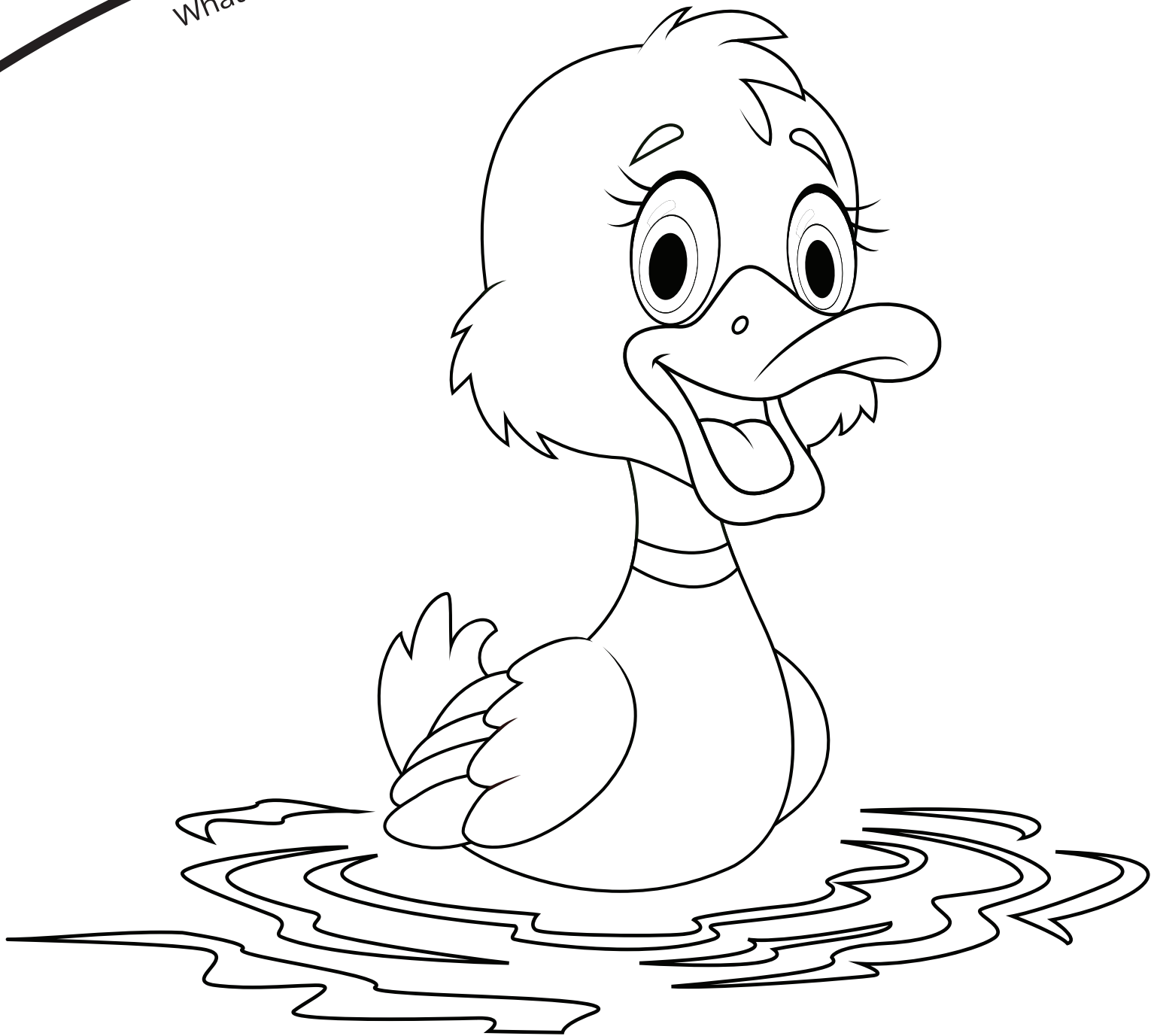

What friends does duck have? Can you draw a friend for duck?



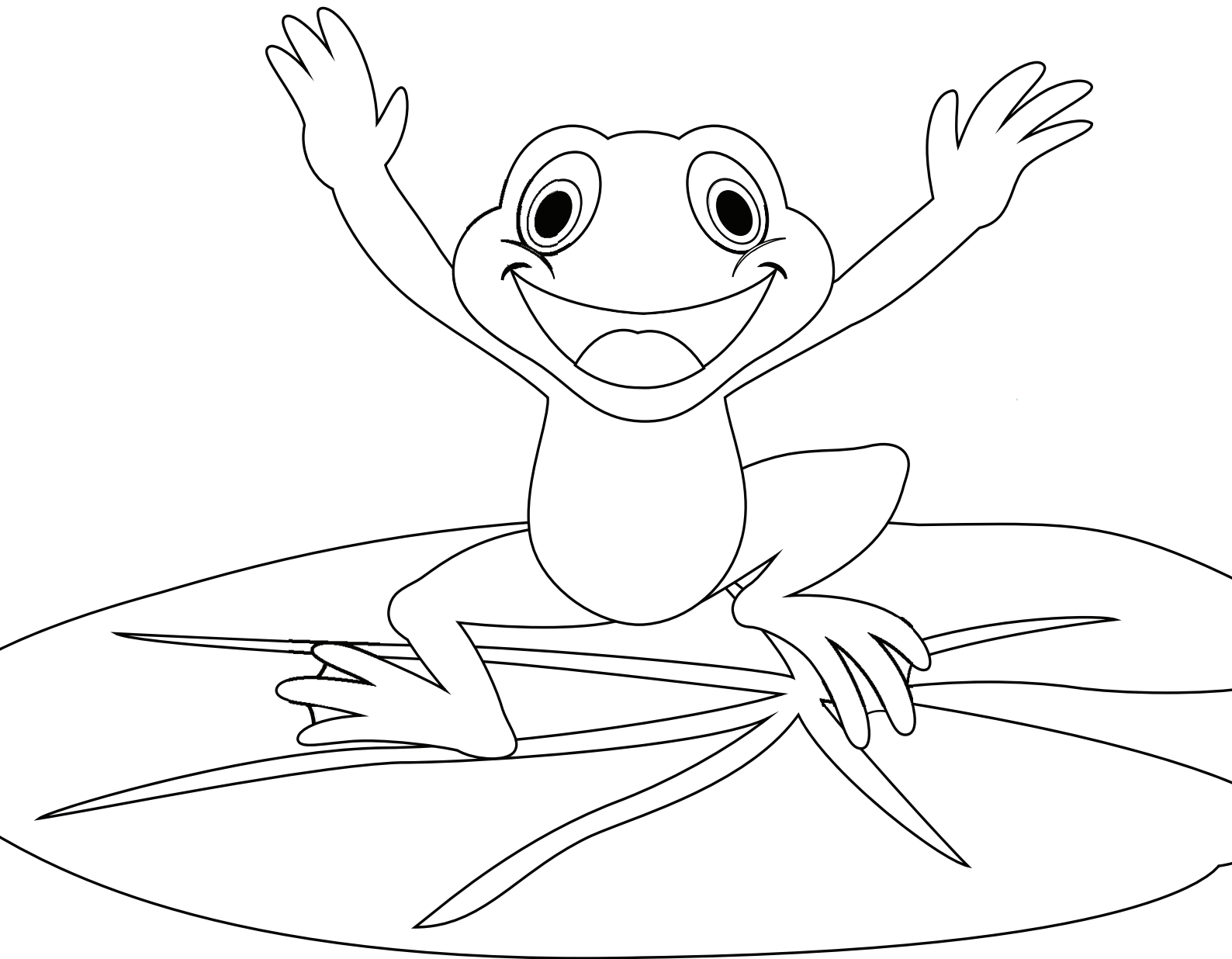
During play children learn about the world in which they live. They can explore, create, imagine and figure things out!

Follow lines left to right.



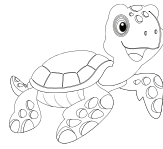
