Conditions of entry

Welcome to Logan Libraries. These conditions of entry support the provision of a safe, welcoming and respectful environment for all library visitors and staff.

Library staff have the authority to ask visitors to leave or modify behaviour to maintain this environment.

These conditions apply to all Logan Libraries' premises and are considered library rules. They apply in addition to all other library rules, library policies and local laws.

Library visitors must:


- treat staff and other library users with respect and courtesy
- abide by all directions given by library staff
- treat library facilities, equipment and property with due care
- maintain reasonable dress and hygiene standards
- take responsibility for all personal belongings and property
- be responsible for their children's use of library resources
- ensure their children that are 12 years and under are actively supervised and follow these conditions of entry.

Library visitors must not:

- assault, threaten, intimidate or harass staff or visitors
- smoke or vape
- display offensive or inappropriate material
- use offensive language or expressions of hatred
- take photos, audio or video recordings of a person without their consent
- operate or solicit a business
- bring any animal into the library, including the foyer other than an accredited assistance animal
- bring any kind of real or toy weapon
- obstruct staff, other library users, or walkways with their belongings
- charge eScooters, eBikes, or any other large lithium-ion batteries within the library premises, excluding the charging of mobility scooters.

In the event of a breach of these rules or any other library rule, library policy or local law, Logan City Council may take any recourse provided for in the Local Law or refer the matter to the Queensland Police Service.

Privacy statement

Logan City Council is collecting your personal information from you, including your name, contact details, date of birth, borrowing and bookings history. We are committed to handling your personal information in accordance with the *Information Privacy Act 2009 (Qld)* and the Queensland Privacy Principles (QPPs).

We collect your personal information when you register for library membership, borrow materials, use library facilities including our computers, rooms and spaces, and when you participate in library programs.

The collection of your personal information is necessary to allow us to:

- manage library memberships and borrowing privileges
- provide access to library resources and services
- monitor and enforce compliance with library behavioural requirements and policies
- communicate with you about library services, events and updates.

We will only use your information for these purposes. It will otherwise not be used or disclosed unless authorised or required by law.

If you choose not to provide the requested personal information, we may be unable to register you as a library member and provide you with access to certain library services or facilities.
